Sani Şener named most powerful 4th leader in construction in the Gulf

TAV Group President & CEO Sani Şener ranked fourth in the Power 100 list of Construction Week Magazine, one of the most prestigious outlets focusing on the construction sector in the Gulf Region. Şener remains the only Turkish businessperson to make it in the top 10 for the last five years.
